Primary Job Duties Include:

Cleaning and maintenance of aquariums in both residential and commercial settings

Identifying and treating fish disease

Identifying problems or potential problems with aquariums and taking the necessary steps to resolve those issues

Applying preventive measures to maintain healthy aquatic environments

Installation, maintenance and repair of aquariums and aquarium components (lights, skimmers, pumps, etc)

Moving aquariums

Water testing

Delivery of fish and fish products to customers.

Recording daily activities, including detailed time logs and product delivery

Other tasks as assigned

Minimal Job Requirements:

Knowledge of aquarium systems (salt water, fresh water and reef tanks) and their components

Knowledge of aquarium environments and their chemical and biological structures

Professional or personal experience with aquarium maintenance

CPR and Scuba Diving Certification (If not certified at time of hire, Reef Tectonics will reimburse for certification upon successful completion of certification requirements)

Interest in fish and aquatic environments

Good driving record-(subject to approval by Reef Tectonics Insurance Provider)

Ability to lift a minimum of (80#)-(2) 5-gallon buckets of water simultaneously

Good oral communication and customer service skills

Must enjoy working with people, be self motivated and organized

Employee must provide own transportation (see mileage reimbursement below)

Must be responsible and able to work independently

Other:

A condition of hire requires signing a non-compete/non-disclosure contract.

Position consists of a combination of Aquarium Maintenance related tasks and Other Tasks

Job may require trips to various markets outside of the employee's assigned area

Position requires employee to be available for work outside of scheduled hours on an 'on call' basis as determined by management

Applicant will be required to provide a copy of valid driver's license, current copy of driving record, current registration, and proof of insurance.**

Mileage reimbursement for use of personal vehicle is currently 32 cents per mile for eligible miles. Eligible miles include those miles driven for the benefit of Reef Tectonics, Inc and does not include those miles which an employee would otherwise drive to commute to and from work each day. Mileage reimbursement rates are adjusted quarterly to reflect changes in fuel prices.
